



2011 GRADE 1 FUTURITIES AT RUIDOSO DOWNS UP MORE THAN 20 PERCENT

The 2011 record-setting All American Futurity, the world's richest Quarter Horse race, sports a 20 percent increase over comparable figures for the 2010 running through the November payment.

The 2011 All American Futurity projects to have a \$2.4-million purse and guarantees the winner \$1.2 million, up for the \$1 million winner's share in recent years.

The estimated \$2.4-million total purse and the guaranteed \$1.2-million winner's share will be all-time records for Quarter Horse racing.

Through the November payment, there are 796 hopefuls eligible for the 2011 record-setting running. This is up from 666 eligible yearlings a year ago for the 2010 edition.

The 2011 renewals of the Rainbow Futurity and the Ruidoso Futurity are showing an even higher increase. The 2011 Rainbow Futurity, which shows a purse increase to \$700,000 for 2011, has 545 yearlings eligible, up from 449 a year ago. This is a 21-percent boost.

The 2011 \$500,000 Ruidoso Futurity has 456 prospect eligible, compared to 372 a year ago. This is a 23-percent increase.

"I want to thank all of the owners and breeders for showing such strong faith in our futurity program at Ruidoso Downs," said Ruidoso Downs' chief executive officer R.D. Hubbard. "The All American Futurity sets

the standard for all of quarter horse racing and our derby program is also at record-setting levels with the All American Derby the richest race for older horses."

The 2010 All American Derby had an all-time record purse of \$1,548,000 and is on pace to match or exceed that figure in 2011.

Nomination to the 2012 All American, Rainbow and Ruidoso futurities is due on January 15, 2011 for foals of 2010. A single payment of \$150 gains eligibility to all of those three futurities that comprise the All American Triple Crown.
